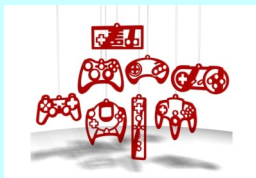
It's time to geek up your holidays! Check out the top Geek holiday decorations:
